Rockefeller could sign his name to a piece of paper and make it worth millions; that is capital.

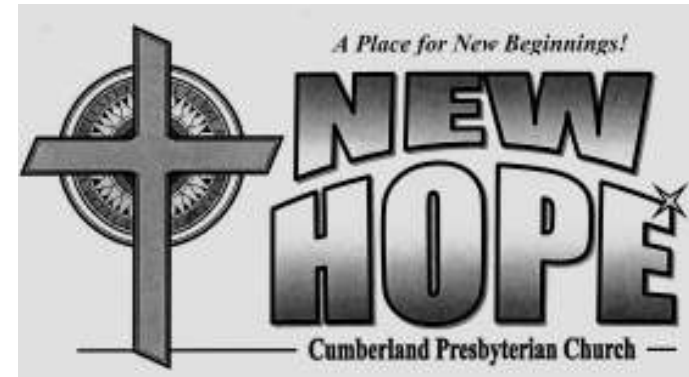
Uncle Sam can take gold, stamp an eagle on it, and make it worth \$20; that is money.
